

Day 1. Sun 02 May 2021 MACKAY - EMERALD

Depart Mackay with an early start for travel through to Emerald in the Central Highlands Region. We'll travel via the Peak Downs Highway which offers some of the most spectacular scenery in the Central Highlands. The Peak Range is a chain of strikingly beautiful mountains between Moranbah, Clermont and Dysart. Our morning tea stop will be in Nebo at the Nebo Museum which houses the Mount Britton Collection of paintings. Continuing along the Peak Downs Highway we'll reach Clermont, one of the most historic towns in Northern Australia. Enjoy a picnic lunch at Hoods Lagoon with time to wander the boardwalks around the Lagoon. Keep an eye out for the famous 'piano in the tree', a replica of an actual piano which was lodged in the tree after a devastating flood in 1916. To capture the grandeur of the region's striking mountain scenery, we'll have a photo stop at Peak Range Lookout in Capella. Continue on to Emerald to check-in and relax. This evening dinner is included at our accommodation.

Day 2. Mon 03 May 2021 EMERALD - LONGREACH

Mitchell Grass Retreat.

If you love gemstones then today is going to be a real treat with a visit to Rubyvale, set in the heart of the Sapphire Gemfields. Join an underground mine tour for a lesson in sapphire mining. Explore the tunnels with your guide then try your luck at fossicking. We'll travel east via the Landsborough Highway to Barcaldine, the Garden City of the West. Visit the new Desert Dreaming Centre to gain an insight into authentic Indigenous and Paleo pastimes. Stand under the historic Tree of Knowledge Memorial famous for being the birthplace of the Australian Labor movement. Check-in to your 5 Star Glamping accommodation early afternoon with time to relax and appreciate the impressive sunset from your Glamping Tent

Visit the Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame to wander the newly refurbished gallery and see the new Outback Cinematic Experience. Travel the short distance to Ilfracombe. Founded in 1891, it was a transport hub for Wellshot Station, which at the time held the largest number of sheep on any station in the world. We'll cap off the tour with an authentic pub lunch at the historic Wellshot Hotel. Return to Mitchell Grass Retreat with time to refresh before the Tastes of Sunset Dinner at historic Rosebank Station. Round out your second night in Longreach with the Luminescent Longreach Sound & Light Show.

Day 4. Wed 05 May 2021 LONGREACH

Join a Camden Park Station Tour for an insider's view into life on the land. Tour the historic shearing shed and share morning tea with owner Outback Dan. Visit the world-class Qantas Founders Museum, eloquently telling the story of the founding of Qantas. View marvelous interpretive and interactive exhibits then join a guided Airpark Tour. Spend some free time in downtown Longreach. Late afternoon we unwind on the Drover's Sunset Cruise with tasty on-board nibbles followed by a two-course table service dinner under the stars at Smithy's Outback Dinner & Show.

Travel west to Winton and learn the story behind Australia's unofficial national anthem at the Waltzing Matilda Centre; the only museum dedicated to a song. Featuring high-tech 3D animation and illustrations you'll be taken on a fascinating narrative of Australia's aviation history.



Sunset Cruise & Smithy's Outback Dinner & Show

Waltzing Matilda Museum

The first museum in the world dedicated to a song, the new Waltzing Matilda Centre boasts state of the art interpretation, telling the story of Waltzing Matilda. The Qantilda Museum offers interactive displays telling the story and history of the Winton Shire, including the Great Shearers Strike of 1891, and the birth of QANTAS. Exhibitions aside, the new Waltzing Matilda Centre is a sight to behold in itself. It was designed by award winning architects, Cox Architecture.



Age of Dinosaurs Museum & BBQ Dinner

Visit the Australian Age of Dinosaurs with the largest collection of Australian dinosaur bones in the world. Hear how the bones are surfacing and are dug up right here in the Winton region and remain in the area to be prepared and added to an amazingly progressive dinosaur museum. You will see real bones and professional animation to recreate the dinosaurs before your eyes. Join a guided interpretive tour of the laboratory, collection room and Dinosaur Canyon followed by our very own special sunset barbecue overlooking the plains where the dinosaurs once roamed!



Lark Quarry Tour

Dinosaur Stampede National Monument at Lark Quarry Conservation Park (also known just as Lark Quarry or Dinosaur Stampede) is considered to be the site of the world's only known record of a dinosaur stampede. The fossilised footprints are interpreted as a predator stalking and causing a stampede of around 150 two-legged dinosaurs. The fossils date to either the Albian or Turonian periods between 104 to 92 million years ago, and are part of the Winton Formation sandstone.



Venus Gold Battery Tour

On the outskirts of Charters Towers sits the oldest and largest surviving Battery in Queensland – The Venus Gold Battery. Built in 1872, this mill provided gold extraction facilities to miners for over a century. The huge "stampers" pounded away through the day and night extracting the precious gold from quartz up until 1973. The Venus Gold Battery is of national and cultural significance, and well worth a visit. One of the highlights is a fascinating film presentation that shows not only the process of extracting gold from ore, but also the story of the Battery's working life and some of its ghosts.


